Documents Required to Qualify for Admissions Testing

Applying for Pre-K through Grade 1:

- _____ To attend Pre-K, a student must be 4 years old on or before September 30, 2018, as verified by an **attached copy of the birth certificate**.
- _____ To attend kindergarten, a student must be 5 years old on or before September 30, 2018, as verified by an **attached copy of the birth certificate**.
- _____ All students applying for Pre-K through 1st grade must submit a copy of the birth certificate.
- _____ All students applying for Pre-K through 1 must currently live in Jefferson Parish as verified by an attached copy of one of the following: driver’s license, state ID, current utility bill, or other official document.

Applying for Grades 2 through 5:

- _____ A copy of the most recent report card must be attached.
- _____ A student’s age must be verified by an attached copy of the birth certificate.
- _____ The student must also currently live in Jefferson Parish as verified by an attached copy of one of the following: driver’s license, state ID, current utility bill, or other official document.

Applying for Grades 6th through 12th

- _____ Proof of residency
 - The student must currently live in Jefferson Parish as verified by an attached copy of one of the following: driver’s license, state ID, current utility bill, or other official document.
- _____ Report cards
 - Attach copies of the last two years final (end of year) report card. All final course grades in reading, English, math, science, AND social studies courses are a “C” or higher.
- _____ Standardized Test Scores:
 - Standardized test scores with percentiles from the **2016-2017** school year. The overall composite score is at or above the 85th percentile. OR
 - **2016-2017** school year iLEAP or LEAP scores. The student must score a minimum of Mastery in both English/Language Arts and math. OR
 - **2016-2017** school year End of Course (EOC) test scores from statewide testing. Student must score a minimum of “Good” in English and/or math. OR
 - Qualifying **2016-2017** school year standardized test scores from another state or country.

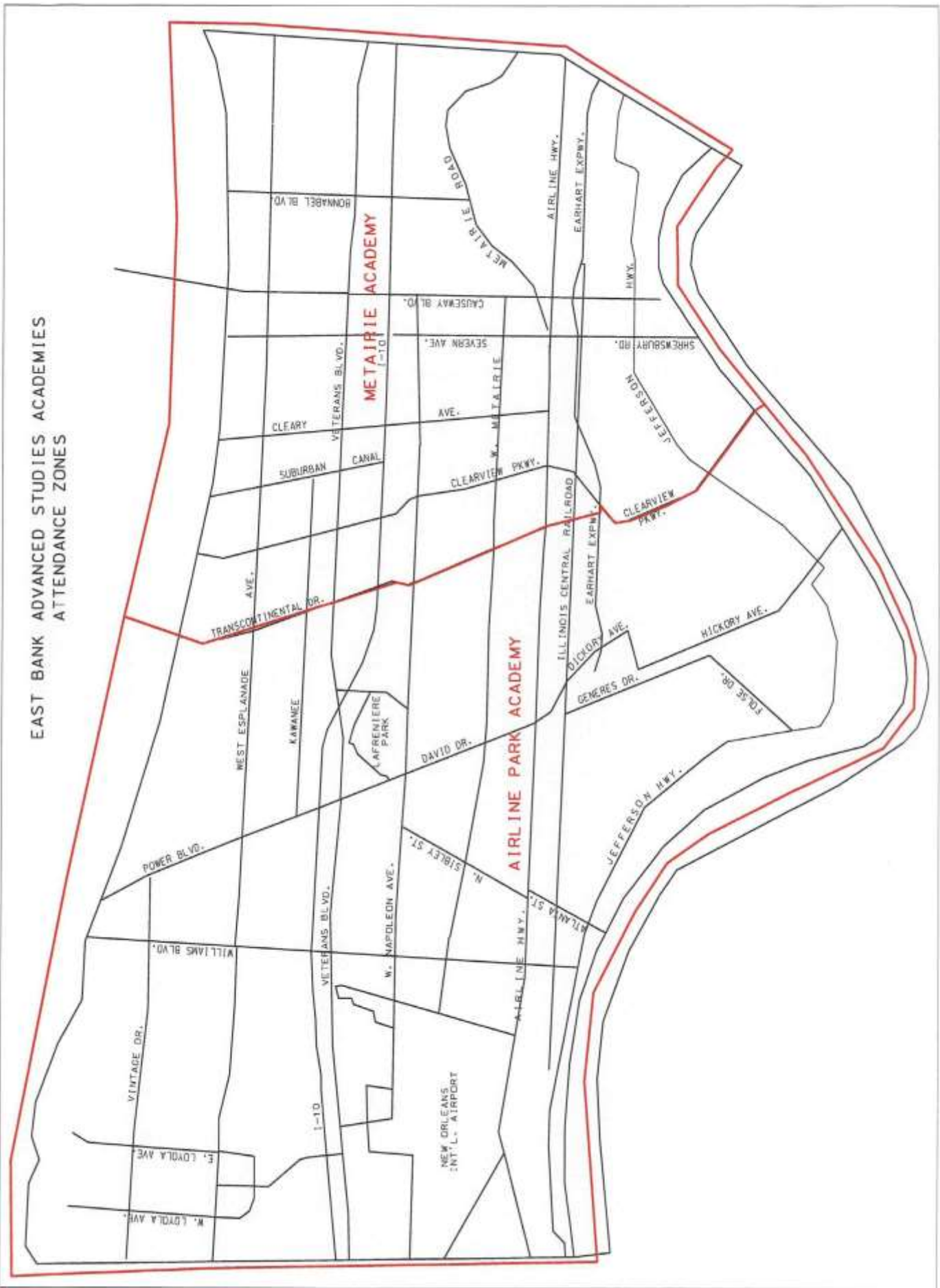
- ❖ There are 132 5th graders on the east bank who may choose to move up to Haynes or Patrick Taylor for 6th grade.
- ❖ There are 121 5th graders on the west bank who may choose to move up to Ruppel or Patrick Taylor for 6th grade.
- ❖ There are 253 5th graders total eligible for a total of 375 6th grade seats, leaving 122 6th grade seats available to new admits for 2018-2019.
- ❖ Thomas Jefferson has a capacity to accept 125 9th grade west bank students.
- ❖ There are 63 8th grade students at Ruppel Academy who may choose to move up to Thomas Jefferson or Patrick Taylor for 9th grade.

Important Notes:

1. Privately administered standardized tests or evaluations are not accepted. Certificates, letters of recommendation, awards, etc. are not factored into the admissions process.
2. If for any reason your child is unable to test on his/her scheduled testing date, only one makeup date will be offered by the admissions office. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to notify the admissions office as soon as possible if the child will not be testing on his/her scheduled date. Admissions office – (504) 349-7792
3. Once a child has gone into the testing room and begins testing, there will be no makeup/retest opportunity for the upcoming school year.
4. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to notify the admissions office if your child requires testing accommodations as documented on a current IEP or IAP. No accommodations can be provided unless they are specified on the accommodations pages on a current IEP or IAP which must be submitted at the time of application.
5. The Appeals Committees adhere strictly to Board Approved Policies and Procedures. Decisions made by the Appeals Committees are final.
