- If applying for grades 2 – 11, the final report card from the 2017-2018 school year

ATTENDANCE ZONES

Qualifying applicants will only be approved for the Magnet Program designated for the side of the river on which the applicant resides.

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICANT

- To be eligible for admission into a Magnet Program
 - a. Student must be a current resident of Jefferson Parish. Current proof of residency and birth certificate must be submitted with the application.
 - b. When applying for grades 2 and above, students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 in core subjects (language arts, math, science, social studies) as evidenced by the final report card submitted from the year prior to application.
- To be eligible for a Magnet Transfer to the French or Spanish Immersion program for grades K-8:
 - a. Student must be a current resident of Jefferson Parish. Current proof of residency and birth certificate must be submitted with the application.
 - b. Parent(s) of students entering grades 2-8 must show documentation that their child has previously been enrolled in a French or Spanish Immersion program OR the student must demonstrate a minimum of 85% proficiency on a grade level target language proficiency test.
 - c. Students entering grades 2-8 must have at least a 2.0 GPA in core subjects (language arts, math, science, social studies) as evidenced by the final report card submitted from the year prior to application.
- To be eligible for a Magnet Transfer into an IB Program in grades 6 and above:
 - a. Student must be a current resident of Jefferson Parish. Current proof of residency and birth certificate must be submitted with the application.
 - b. Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 in core subjects (language arts, math, science, social studies) as evidenced by the final report card submitted from the year prior to application.
 - c. Student must enroll in at least two honors, AP, or IB courses per semester.

REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENTS TO REMAIN IN A MAGNET PROGRAM

- A student must maintain a final unweighted 2.0 GPA in all coursework except PE and health.

TRANSPORTATION WILL BE PROVIDED

- JPPSS shall provide transportation for magnet school students to the magnet school in their attendance zone.

DECISION NOTIFICATIONS

Admission into Magnet Programs is determined by the student's eligibility (see above), capacity at the requested school, and the order in which the application was submitted.

Decision notifications will be sent from the Compliance Office via U.S. mail to be received by March 30, 2019.

If your child is accepted into a magnet school, you will receive an Acceptance Letter from the Compliance Office which will include the date, time and location of registration.

MAGNET PROGRAM APPLICATIONS ARE NOT ACCEPTED FOR PRE- K OR FOR STUDENTS ENTERING THEIR SENIOR YEAR.

OTHER CRITERIA FOR MAGNET SCHOOL/MAGNET PROGRAM TRANSFERS

Transfers for students in grades kindergarten through seven shall be made at least 30 days prior to the commencement of a school year or, where permitted by a particular magnet program with sufficient grade level capacity to accept a transferring magnet student, at least 30 days prior to the beginning of the second semester of a school year. Students in grades 8 through 10 seeking enrollment in a magnet school shall submit the appropriate transfer form at least 30 days prior to the commencement of a school year. Students entering into the school system for the first time may seek enrollment in a magnet school upon entering into the School System from another school district or from a private or home school situated within the Parish of Jefferson where such in-term enrollment is permitted by a magnet program and neither grade level nor school overcrowding will result.
