

# Coach Card for Completing the Middle School Universal Screening Document

**Purpose:** The Universal Screening Document Form is designed to assist ABIT members in identifying students who need intervention in the areas of Reading, Math, and Behavior based on iLEAP scores, SSBD, Office Discipline Referrals (ODRs) or Suspensions.

Students names are listed in column 1 if they have scored Unsatisfactory in ELA or Math on the iLEAP, are on the Top Ten list for ODR's, have been identified as "at-risk" on SSBD, or have 2 or more suspensions. (Suspensions can be in-school or out-of-school)

## ELA Section - Columns 2-4

- If the student scored unsatisfactory on the ELA section of iLEAP, place a check in column 2.
- If the student scored Unsatisfactory on the ELA, and is currently placed in Read 180, place a check in column 3
- If the student scored Unsatisfactory on the ELA, and is currently placed in System 44, place a check in column 4.

## Math Section – Column 5

- If the student scored unsatisfactory on the Math section of iLEAP, place a check in column 5.

## Interval Tests – Column 6

- If the student has failed 2 consecutive interval test in a subject and is also failing that subject, place a check in the box in column 6.

## Behavior Section – Columns 7-9

- If the student's name appears on the monthly Top Ten List for ODR's write the number of ODR's the student has listed on the monthly ODR print-out in column 7.
- If the student was identified as "at-risk" on the SSBD screening, place a check in column 8.
- If the student has been suspended, write the number of suspensions in column 9.

## Decisions

- Prioritize the students that will need to be discussed at ABIT by numbering the students from 1 – 20, or more if necessary, in column 10.
- Place a date in column 11 to document when the student will be discussed at ABIT.
