Mr. Morgan, chairman, stated that the Transportation Committee met prior to the Board meeting and submits the following recommendation as a First Reading:

Mr. Henry, chairman, stated that the Organization and Human Resources Committee met prior to the Board meeting and the Restructuring of the Student Information Function and the Change of Job Title and Job Description for Director of Secondary Education were already voted on at this Board meeting.

Mr. Marino, chairman, stated that the Insurance Committee met prior to the Board meeting and submits the following recommendations as First Readings:

A discussion followed.

Mr. Morgan asked that Dr. Licciardi change the word "germane" to "substantially similar". Dr. Licciardi and Mrs. Moran accepted

the amendment.

Mrs. Moran asked that the motion be amended to include "the member being absent from the entire meeting" and not just from this vote.

Dr. Licciardi stated that she would defer her second reading until the Board meeting of July 6, 2005, so that the Board attorney can change the wording to consider the requests of both Mr. Morgan and Mrs. Moran.

Moved by Mrs. Moran that the Special Education students, grades 7 & 8, remain at Haynes Middle School for the next two school years, 2005-2006 and 2006-2007.

Mrs. Moran asked Mrs. Barbara Adams, Assistant Superintendent of Special Education, to explain why this process would not be in the best interest of the students.

Mrs. Adams stated that out of the 50 special education students, 41 would have to be in inclusion classes. She also stated that these classes would be for accelerated students at Haynes Middle Magnet, and she would not recommend that these special education students be in these advanced classes.

Mrs. Moran withdrew her second reading.

FIRST READING

The following first reading was submitted by Mr. Katsanis:

That the Pre-K Center, currently under construction at John Clancy Elementary School in Kenner, be named the "Chris Lochbaum Pre-K Center." Mr. Lochbaum was the founding principal at Clancy Elementary and served as its educational leader for 20 years before retiring in 1975.

Mr. Katsanis read Resolution No. 42, which was passed by the Jefferson Parish Council on June 8, 2005, which requested the Jefferson Parish Administration to investigate the possibility of offering adult education to the citizens of Jefferson Parish. Mr. Katsanis stated that the School Board has no intention of discontinuing our Adult Education services. He also stated that a new site for the program will be formalized.

Mr. St. Pierre requested that he, the Superintendent, Mr. Morgan, Mrs. Barnes and Dr. Licciardi meet with Councilman Chris Roberts to discuss the matter of the Jefferson Parish Council and the Jefferson Parish School Board possibly entering into a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement concerning facilities.

Dr. Roussel stated her concerns about the school system's accountability with the state for the Adult Education program and the need for oversight of the program.

Dr. Licciardi stated that she and Mr. Katsanis attended the recent graduation ceremony of the Adult Education program and that it was a very rewarding experience. She also stated that more than 800 citizens earned their GED through our Adult Education program this year.

Mrs. Moran stated that the Coordinator-Consultant in charge of the Patrick F. Taylor Science and Technology Academy will be certified as a principal in August.

Delegations were allowed to address the Board.

Mr. Tom Meyer, Jefferson Chamber, thanked the Board for allowing the Patrick F. Taylor Science and Technology Academy to remain at Special Services Center for one more year. He offered assistance from the Chamber. Mr. Meyer praised Dr. Roussel for her accomplishments and stated that his organization believes in her leadership.

Mr. William R. "Bob" Lewis thanked the Board for allowing the students at the Patrick F. Taylor Science and Technology Academy to remain at the present site and for discussing transportation to the magnet schools.

Taylor Science and Technology Academy to remain; she thanked Mr. St. Pierre for his strong leadership; she thanked Dr. Roussel for forming Committee I and Committee II. She also invited the Board to the back to school barbecue for Science and Technology parents at 822 Clearview Parkway, on August 20, 2005, and to the open house on August 23, 2005.

Vickie Rands, transportation chairman of the parent committee, stated that they have been contacting private schools, airport parking, and the Treasure Chest Casino regarding transportation of the students.

Joe Potts, President Jefferson Federation of Teachers, praised the Board and administrative staff for putting together the budget, for rolling the millage forward which helped fund unfunded mandates, for the committee meetings on Thursday and Friday for the Science and Technology School, and for approving his leave without pay for 18 years.
