This contract is intended to insure that both students and parents are aware of the Behavioral Standards required of the students enrolling in an Alternative School in the Jefferson Parish School System.

A student may be placed in an Alternative School for a minimum of 90-days, Remainder of the School Year or Extended Year as determined by the Hearing Officer. A student may also be considered for the Alternative School if he/she exhibits a need for intensive supervision and support services. Qualifications for the placement must include such serious constant disruption of the classroom and/or school that the education of other students is impacted.

Note:

As a student enrolling in any Alternative School, both parent and student understand that the student must meet the exit requirements before returning to their attendance zone school.

Any gross misconduct or unlawful act may result in the immediate removal from the Alternative School.
