

# PARENTAL RIGHTS

## Disciplinary Actions



### Family Rights and Privacy Act of 1974

Principals/designees follow policies in this act, in instances of when parents/legal guardians seek information about the student who may have caused injury or damage their child.

### If parents are not satisfied with information provided

The parent/legal guardian of the injured child may seek redress through legal action under civil law.



### Parents must return to school with student

At middle/high school levels, following second and third suspensions the administrator shall schedule a conference for the student with a counselor.

### Suspension lengths

- 3 day suspensions = Parent/legal guardian conference shall follow
- 9 day suspensions = Hearing Officer is notified and parent/legal guardian conference shall be conducted within 3 days of suspension



### Suspension Appeal

If unsatisfied with the suspension, parents have a right to appeal the ruling.

### Suspension Make-up Work

Students who are removed from class for ten days or less shall be assigned school work missed and shall receive full or partial credit if it is completed satisfactorily and timely as determined by the principal or designee, upon the recommendation of the teacher.
