



JPPSS Overview:

Reviewing Transitional Student Growth Data (TSGD)

(Updated 5.4.16)

EVALUATOR DIRECTIONS: Please review the information below.

1. TSGD Eligibility:

- Qualifying teachers of the subjects listed below will receive a TSGD percentile ranking for each subject AND a Composite percentile ranking:
 - 4th- 8th grade ELA, Math and Science
 - Algebra I
 - Geometry

2. Informal Observations:

- Teachers with a *composite* percentile ranking of **Highly Effective** (80th percentile or above) will be eligible to have their Informal Observation waived for the 2016-2017 school year.
- A list of eligible teachers will be sent to each school by the school's Compass contact.
- Eligible teachers will complete the attached TSGD Highly Effective Observation Waiver form. All eligible teachers must complete and return the form.
- Principals should return all completed forms to their Compass contact.

3. Reviewing Transitional Student Growth Data

- The Transitional Student Growth Data – Teacher Results Report in CIS will identify the Composite ranking as well as all subject rankings for each teacher on your roster. The report also identifies previous year Composite rankings for teachers who received TSGD during the previous school year.
- The Student Growth Data Report for each teacher (available on the Student Growth Data tab in CIS) will show each student's projected score, the actual assessment score and the difference that is used to calculate the teacher's Transitional Student Growth score.
- **REMEMBER:** The data that is being published now is from the 2015-2016 school year. To access these reports:
 - a.) Click "View Only" in the top right corner of the CIS screen (on the dark blue bar).
 - b.) Select the 2015-2016 school year from the School Session menu.
